It is clear from your plans that the Council have decided to dump on Byfleet. The vast majority of green belt land being released under the plan is in our village or West Byfleet. The rest of the borough's green belt seems to be escaping unscathed.

Byfleet suffers from flooding and the two areas chosen to build on are in the flood plains of the Wey and the Wey navigation canal so things can only get worse.

The Parvis Road (A245) is already a traffic black spot with major tailbacks during rush hours. The increase in population in the two villages can only make it worse.

The infrastructure in and around the village is inadequate for current needs. The Parvis Road flood whenever it rains heavily and the drainage system cannot cope. We lack medical facilities in the village and the Health Centre in West Byfleet is struggling to cope with current numbers.
