OBJECTION TO LOSS OF GREEN BELT WOKING

We would like to formally object to the loss of Green Belt via its release for housing development and traveler sites in Woking. We object to any loss of Green Belt but we have major objection to the 400+ houses proposed in Pyrford in the 2 fields adjacent to Upshot lane as this will have a direct and negative effect on our quality of life in Pyrford, Woking.

The Green Space, availability of walking trails, and village feel are essential to the charm and character of Pyrford and the loss of our of Green Belt will directly result in the loss of this character. Pyrford is at risk of becoming like so many other characterless, soulless, new build suburbs and this would extremely detrimental to the residents of Pyrford.

Old Woking Road and other local roads are already very busy and this development will push it to unbearable. We will have more cars using the side streets as a cut through options increasing traffic in these currently quiet streets. This would be completely unacceptable.
