Re: Woking 2027 DPD Consultation and in particular to site references:

GB10 (Land to the north east of Saunders Lane, between Saunders Lane and Hook Hill Lane, Mayford GU22 0NN)

GB11 (Land to the north west of Saunders Lane, Mayford, GU22 0NN)

GB14 (Land adjacent to Hook Hill Lane, Hook Heath, GU22 0PS)

As a resident of Hook Heath I am writing to register my objection to the removal of areas GB10, GB11 and GB14 from the Green Belt and to proposals to build houses on parcels GB10 and GB11 post 2027.

My reasons for objecting are:

Inadequate infrastructure in transport, if you have used any of the surrounding routes around the proposed sites you can only be aware of the severe congestion at peak times. A proposed new school and retail park will put even more pressure on roads.

Not only pressure on transport but provision of other facilities such as doctors, dentists schools all need to be in place before any development. Since all councils are facing constant cuts in budgets were and how are these to be financed.

The density of proposed housing will change the character of the area forever and contradicts the meaning of Green Belt, namely, to maintain the open spaces between towns and villages which these proposals do not.
