Hello Jeni,

We are emailing you to register our strongest objections to the Borough proposals to develop the two fields, either side of Upshot Lane in Pyrford.

Apart from the inexcusable destruction of Green Belt land and its dire consequences for other parts of Surrey, this is an ill thought out proposal for the following reasons:

Pyrford's attraction as an attractive rural suburb of Woking will become devalued; the inevitable traffic pollution will become intolerable and the pressure on local services will become insupportable. A village built in 1955 can hardly maintain adequate services today in 2015. Without major works to upgrade Water and Sewerage infrastructure, road widening and support services (medical, scholastic, telecoms) the project can only offer the worst of all possible worlds.

We simply cannot understand how the Borough has failed to grasp these important issues. We therefore urge you in the strongest terms to reconsider your building proposals.
