Dear Ms Jackson,

I am a resident of Pyrford and have just received information stating that Woking BC plan to build over 400 new homes on 2 sites in the village. I would like to formally register my disapproval of this development. Increasing the number of residents and road users would completely over-pressurise our narrow access roads, particularly as the houses are planned for the Ripley side of the village. The local school is also over-subscribed and the green areas surrounding the village are what makes it keep its character - rather than develop into the urban sprawl of outer London. Residents already have too few areas to walk their dogs, and replacing green land with houses will narrow this down further and lead to overcrowding of the few areas of local green space available.

I would be most grateful if you could consider not pursuing with this housing plan.
