

## **Proposed Housing in Upshot Lane, Pyrford**

We are writing to register our objection to the proposal to build over 400 dwellings in the Upshot Lane area.

In particular Pyrford cannot cope with the increase in traffic that would be caused by this development - there are already bottlenecks, for traffic leaving Pyrford, at the Anchor and Newark Lane, Ripley. Furthermore parked cars outside Pyrford School and Church often reduce the road to a single lane.

On a different point these fields are used for spreading sewage sludge each year, health considerations mean that only certain fields (eg those growing a biofuel crop) can be used for this process and their loss would cause a local shortage of suitable land for sewage sludge disposal.
