Subject: Public Consultation re Proposal to release Green Belt land bounding Upshot Lane for residential development

Dear Ms Jackson

As a resident of Pyrford for the past 22-23 years, I am appalled that WBC should be considering releasing this Green Belt land for residential development – particularly when, as I understand it, this in part goes against the recommendation of your own Planning Consultant.

At present, Pyrford comes to an orderly and appropriate interface with the Green Belt around the old Rowley Bristow Hospital, Aviary Road and Upshot Lane – one that has been established for a hundred years or more. New development beyond this would be totally out of keeping with the parish and destroy the current environment of the community.

Notwithstanding the massively detrimental impact on the local heritage views, such a development would be totally out of keeping with the local infrastructure and would inevitably involve substantial upgrade to local roads with the added destruction of the Green Belt that this would bring. In addition, Pyrford simply does not have the local infrastructure to handle the additional volume of people such a development would bring – particularly the local primary school which has no room to expand and already creates massive traffic congestion twice a day.

Please register this note as my objection to the proposed development.
