Dear Ms Jackson,

I am writing to express my strong objection to the potential future development of houses on the fields either side of Upshot Lane in Pyrford.

For myself and many other people emerging from the outskirts of Pyrford onto the road to Ripley the views across and over these fields reminds us that we live in the beautiful Surrey countryside. These views and that sense of countryside would be lost forever if development were to go ahead.

Living in Pine Tree Hill, I am acutely aware of the level of traffic already present on Pyrford Common Road and the dangerousness of the junction between the Old Woking Road and Norfolk Farm Road. I have witnessed many near misses here because of the inadequate speed restrictions, signage and road markings for filter lanes, and there are fairly frequent accidents. This situation can only deteriorate if the level of local traffic increases.
