Dear Ms. Jackson

This email is to register our objection to the plan to build 423 new houses on the two fields in Upshot Lane in Pyrford. My wife Audrey and me have lived in Pyrford for 34 years from May 1981. We are both concerned the impact of such a large increase in the population will have on many aspects of everyday life here.

The demands on public services such as schools, medical facilities and roads will be overwhelming. The roads in and around Pyrford and West Byfleet are already overcrowded and the availability of parking is currently an ongoing problem which will be exasperated by such an increase in the number of vehicles using the roads. It is inevitable that the area will be subject to log jams on a regular basis.

The Health Centre in West Byfleet will likewise be affected by the substantial increase in numbers using it, At present waiting times to make an appointment can be excessive as there is a high ratio of elderly people in the area.

Finally one assumes that the local schools will likewise be stretched to breaking point by such an increase in the number of pupils that will have to be accommodated.
