The number of houses proposed simply can not be accommodated for a number of reasons. The village infrastructure could not possibly cope with the arrival of at least 500-1000 extra people. The roads can barely cope with today's traffic at certain times of the day.

How is West Byfleet Health Centre going to manage, when patients now often have to wait more than seven days for an appointment?

Pyrford School is already oversubscribed, with so many people in the area wishing to send their children to this excellent school. How could the school accommodate possibly hundreds of additional children?

Why is Woking Council proposing such a development on Greenbelt land; and land which is currently being farmed?

I am completely opposed to this proposal which will change the character of the village of Pyrford .
