Subject: Objection to New Houses on green belt in Pyrford
Dear Jeni Jackson

I am lodging a strong objection to the plans for 423 houses on the two fields on either side of Upshot Lane in the plans for the period 2015-2010. This land is in the current green belt and should stay as such. One of these fields was not recommended as appropriate for use by the councils' own planning consultants in the review of 2014.

My family have lived in Pyrford for 33 years and enjoy its rural aspect. The nature of the village and the surrounding green landscape were the prime reasons that we chose to move here. Our roads are already extremely busy, through all the local villages. Such a large quantity of houses would cause total gridlock. In addition, local infrastructure is already pushed to its limits. Schools, hospitals, doctors surgeries - all are inadequate for a further 400+ families. In my opinion, such housing would be disastrous for Pyrford.
