Is the hospital in Chertsey going to be expanded, the waiting time is already extremely long Will there be more walk in centres to help the hospital Will there be another doctors surgery Will the schools be expanded Will the roads be better organised and widened in places, West Byfleet is already grid locked at school times and lunch time Are you going to provide proper transport as it is very poor in Pyrford How long will the building take, the disruption and noise will presumably go on for some months, not to mention the extra traffic with heavy lorries Will the utilities be able to cope, we already have problems with BT lines, water pressure at my house Will we have any green areas kept safe My final query is how are these houses being funded? We have tried for years to try and get 2 more street lamps down our road to make it safer and yet they do not have funding for them?
