I do understand the need for more housing in the woking area and therefore assume that no Brownfield land in this area will be listed on the Governments national register undeveloped land which is to be created.

I strongly object to the release of any Green Belt land to the following sites.

GB8 Land adjacent to Egley Road, Mayford. I object to the release of Green Belt land and the traffic jams, development would cause.

GB7 Land at 10 Acre Farm Smarts Heath Road

I object because any increase to the Traveller site would reduce the openness of the Green Belt

Area.

GB9 Woking Garden Centre Egley Road

I object because of the extra traffic that would need to use Egley Road

GB10 Land North East of Saunders Lane.

I object to any Green Belt development

GB11 Land North West of Saunders Lane Mayford

I object to any Green Belt development.

GB14 Land adjacent to Hook Hill Lane, Hook Heath (for Green infrastructure) I object.
