Subject: Objection to Proposed Houses in Pyrford

Dear Jeni

We wish to submit our objection to the proposed building of 423 new houses in Pyrford.

Our reasons are as follows:

- we chose to live in Pyrford for its green landscape, not to be surrounded by a mass of houses
- it will affect the environment hugely, the nature and beauty of this area and will ultimately impact on the varied wildlife, wild animal and bird population.
- we do not believe that the infrastructure around Pyrford and West Byfleet could cope with the additional inhabitants. It is not easy to get an appointment at West Byfleet Medical Centre at the best of times and parking will be even more difficult.
- there is insufficient school places even now.
- the volume of traffic will increase even more significantly. The road network can't cope at present especially at peak times along the Parvis Road from Byfleet.

We strongly object to the proposed plans and wish our objection to be noted.
