Dear Sirs,

We would like to object most strongly to the development of the green belt.

There has not been enough consideration or consultation with regard to development, and brown field sites should be used firstly.

Particularly in Byfleet where nearly all the green belt is being proposed for development whereas 98% of the remainder of Woking Borough is unaffected.

The infrastructure in Byfleet has already been stretched from development and there is already insufficient school places and no medical facilities, the nearest being in West Byfleet.

The only route out of Byfleet, Parvis Road, is already heavily congested and cannot take more demands. It will cause further gridlock.

Flood plains in Byfleet have been built on and any further development will vastly increase the flood risk.

Byfleet has previously submitted a petition with 2,500 names objecting to the loss of the green belt and given this level of objection you must reconsider and not build on the green belt land.
