Subject: Green Belt Release in Byfleet

Dear sir/madam

I object to Woking Council's Site Allocations DPD in relation to release of Green Belt in Byfleet and my comments are as follows:

- 1 The Green Belt must be preserved – other land is available
- 2 The Parvis Road will become unusable and Byfleet will be gridlocked – this is often the case already
- 3 Much of Byfleet and the proposed area has been flooded or is in danger of flooding
- 4 This removes most of the local Green Belt whilst 98% of Woking's is preserved
- 5 The Byfleet petition with some 2,500 names has been ignored
- 6 The current infrastructure provision for education, health, sewerage, roads etc is already inadequate and must be rectified before any new development
