Dear Jeni,

I am writing to register my objection to the potential change of Green Belt status of sites GB12 and GB13 and the proposed housing development on these sites.

Pyrford is a village and the community wishes for it to remain so. It's surrounded by unspoilt countryside and those of us who live here do so because we appreciate the peace and quiet. Having an additional 400+ homes will put a strain on our community services and infrastructure (schools, nurseries, medical practices, utilities, roads to name a few). Pyrford has many historic buildings and conservation areas which would be threatened by removal of the green belt status, not to mention the threat to wildlife. Development on the proposed scale would ruin the rural setting which currently enhances the village.
