Dear Ms Jackson,

We truly value the green open spaces, the trees, the river/canal, the water meadows and the village feel of Pyrford. If the proposed development of 423 houses in Pyrford on Upshot Lane together with the 700+ in West Byfleet and ?2000+new homes proposed for Wisley Airfield then the rural village feel of Pyrford will be wrecked and the current infrastructure will be unable to support the additional traffic, and the demand for school places and health services. Coldharbour Rd is already struggling to cope with the traffic at school drop off and pick up for Pyrford Primary School, also making it dangerous for children to walk, cycle, scoot to school. We feel Old Woking Rd is already far too busy (noisy) and fast, and will only get busier. Many children (including ours) need to cross Old Woking Rd to get to Pyrford Primary School by scooter or bicycle. Ideally we need another island (such as at Forest Rd and Pyrford Common Rd end) between Blackdown Avenue and Pyrford Woods, to allow children to cross Old Woking Rd more safely. The proposed development will have a massive negative impact on Pyrford Common Rd and Newark Lane into Ripley. Newark Lane, again, already struggles to cope with rush hour traffic. Please kindly consider the impact on the road traffic that this development will have, and the impact on families and children, who would like to enjoy living in a small village where it is safe to walk, cycle, scoot to school, village shops, pyrford common and park etc. We, for example, moved out of London for this lifestyle change, and would be extremely sad to see this change with overdevelopment of the area.
