Dear Ms Jackson,

Please accept this email to you as a firm objection to the proposed plan to develop in excess of 400 homes on the Upshott Lane fields in Pyrford.

I first encountered Pyrford some years ago after a walk followed in a book of 'Surrey walks'. Included because of its beautiful countryside and wildlife I will always remember following a lovely footpath and bridleway, which runs along side one of the fields you propose to build upon. To this day I encounter walkers along the same route as I explore the neighbouring woodland these fields have with my children.

As a housing officer, for a local authority I am well aware of the housing shortage in the UK, however I urge you to reconsider these plans. Pyrford cannot cope with the volume of housing proposed, schools are already oversubscribed, the gp surgeries continuously working on an emergency appointment basis, and the road infrastructure would not cope, we would be in a permanent state of gridlock.

Please keep Pyrford a special part of the Surrey green belt and do not ruin this community or the beautiful piece of countryside we live in.
