I am writing to object to the proposed development at Uphot Lane. As a resident of Pyrford who moved to the area from Elmbridge nearly 4 years ago to raise a family, I feel it would be a huge shame to have the exact reason I moved here destroyed by over development.

The proposal to build 400 plus dwellings at Upshot Lane is nothing short of excessive. There simply isn't the infrastructure to support this level of development in Pyrford. I have two sons coming to school age and there's already talk of difficulty getting in to Pyrford C of E Primary, despite the school being at the end of my road! That situation is not likely to improve with such a huge growth in local population. Equally, roads such as Boltons Lane, Coldharbour Road, Engliff Lane and Pyrford Road will see a big uplift in daily traffic with an additional 600 odd cars commuting too and from the development. Clearly this will have a negative impact on the quality of life for current residents! Not to mention create chaos outside Pyrford C of E primary school.

This proposed development stands to destroy the local environment and with it community spirit. I know the world can't stand still, but by the same token, can it not move forward with a little more grace and sympathy? I mean; 400 plus properties... Really? Not exactly in keeping with the area is it. I honestly wouldn't have objected if I thought the plan were more sensible (like 100 / 150 properties).
