Dear Ms Jackson

I understand that it is proposed to build 423 new homes on two Pyrford fields either side of Upshot Lane together with other developments due in Pyrford, Byfleet, West Byfleet. I wish to object to these plans as Pyrford is fast becoming overcrowded in terms of people and housing and also with traffic. Our family has been Pyrford residents for some 30 years now and in that time, there has been a dramatic increase in housing and particularly on the density of it, as people have continuously built in gardens, schools etc. This has added to traffic and the weekends now consist of rush hour style traffic everywhere and making it very unpleasant. The much heralded Olympic cycle route has also added to this confusion and groups of cyclists are prevalent at weekends making life hazardous for all forms of transport.

On the plans of having had experience of 'travellers' who are generally lawless and aggressive, I object strongly to the additional plans to provide sites for them in the surrounding areas. I have been personally threatened by them when asking them to move off business premises and by their children who are abusive too, and therefore my objections are founded on reality and actual dealings with the people. There are more points that could be raised about their behaviour, such as thieving, rubbish left behind etc but their aggressive attitude generally is unacceptable.
