I feel very upset and angry about this. I moved to Pyrford from London twenty eight years ago. I was attracted by it's semi-rural feel and lovely fields which I see and appreciate every day I drive through them or on my regular walks following heart surgery.

How sad that these characteristics that make Pyrford what it is, might possibly be ruined. If further houses were built on the current perimeters of Woking town it would not have anywhere near as dramatic an effect and change on a community as it would here.

For example, what about the area south of Woking on the 320? There is a vast area of land there between Woking and Guildford. 400 homes there either side of the road would not ruin the surroundings as they would do here.

What about the vast increase in cars in the area? The main route through the village gets very busy as it is at certain times of day, how is going to cope with a further 800 cars (most homes have two cars nowadays).

Then there is the rest of the infrastructure, schooling for children, medical facilities etc.
