

Objection to the release of Green Belt land Woking Councils Site Allocations DPD

To whom it concerns,

I wish to express my objections to the proposed release of green belt land in Byfleet as proposed.

At a meeting not so long ago it was discussed that the green belt should not be given over to a travellers site nor houses, something that seems to have been backtracked upon with these recent proposals. The council should consider brownfield sites and offer developers concessions on the red-tape (and costs) to develop such land before opening up green belt sites.

The number of proposed houses is too great, the local road, schools, doctors surgery and infrastructure as a whole would not cope - its almost at breaking point now due to years of under investment.

Further the local area has suffered flooding and this will worsen with less green belt and more hard standing.

May I echo again, this plan is flawed and I urge you to reconsider it, I and my family object to it in full.
