Subject: Green belt and building

Dear Ms Jackson,

I am writing to express my concern regarding the proposed removal of the two green belt fields in Pyrford. Firstly, I do not agree with altering the status of this land and secondly, even if these fields were brown field sites, I would not agree with the building of houses here.

Although I appreciate the need for more houses to be built, my main concerns centre around the problems that will arise with the infrastructure. The school in Pyrford is already oversubscribed and NHS services under severe strain. As far as I am aware, the only GP surgery for the Pyrford/West Byfleet/Byfleet/New Haw area is the one in West Byfleet and, in my experience, it is barely coping with the demand. (I have just had to wait nearly four weeks for an appointment.) I also believe that the roads will also be in danger of frequent gridlock especially at peak times because Pyrford is not the only place in the immediate area that is subject to removal of the green belt and the subsequent building of houses. I urge WBC to think very carefully before making any decisions.
