

## Green Belt Release

Dear Sir,

I am writing to state strongly my concerns and objections to the proposals represented regarding the release of green belt land. I am particularly concerned about the land in Byfleet, which is where I live.

The proposals to provide this vast number of homes and other amenities over the coming years is unacceptable for the following reasons:

- Building a school for around 900 students will cause traffic chaos along what is already a heavily congested Parvis Road.
- Infrastructure to support these proposals, such as drainage, education, health services and roads will be quite inadequate. Some of these are already so.
- Substantial areas of Byfleet, including those in the proposals, have experienced flooding in recent years and with further building this will increase.
- The percentage of green belt in Byfleet, West Byfleet and Pyrford that will potentially be lost is unfairly far in excess of that proposed for Woking. Most of ours will be lost.
- It appears that concerns of local residents already expressed have been ignored. A petition has been signed containing 2500 residents' names.

Finally, the green belt was instituted many years ago as sacrosanct, non-building area.
