Dear Sir,

I wish to object to Woking Borough Council's plan to use green belt land in Byfleet for development.

As a resident of Byfleet I am dismayed that WBC has chosen to ignore the 2,500 people that signed a petition against this.

Developing in Byfleet removes most of our remaining green belt (while 98% of Woking green belt is preserved)

I understand that there is other (no-green belt) land that is available and this should be used instead.

Currently, the Parvis Rd is gridlocked at peak times and will become unusable with the additional cars that 1,400 new homes will produce.

In addition, we have inadequate health and schools for the current population. A new private school in Broadoaks will not meet the requirements of the majority of local families. Byfleet already suffers from poor drainage and much of the proposed areas have flooded or are in danger of flooding.

I am wholeheartedly against the destruction of our green belt and urge you to research more suitable alternatives.
