Proposed 423 Houses on Pyrford Green Belt Land either side of Upshot Lane

We write to object most strongly to the above proposal. Apart from the well documented issues raised by the Pyrford Neighbourhood Forum, which I and my wife whole heartedly endorse. On a personal level, we feel particularly concerned that to add to the pressure on the already congested roads at peak periods around West Byfleet and the demands on sewage and water can only impact on the quality of our lives. We moved to our present house in 1976 attracted by what appeared to be an area well balanced between urban amenities and rural open spaces. Over the years we have witnessed continual development with significant infilling and gradual erosion of those rural open spaces resulting in the pressure on the local infrastructure that we have today. We reiterate we strongly object.
