Dear Sirs, I have lived on Blackhorse Road, Woking, for 27 years and I am extremely concerned about proposals for development in our area. I will refer to specific site references that are a concern to me.

Site ref. GB7 (ten acre farm)

I strongly object to any expansion to increase the number of pitches on this land

My main concern is that this land is adjacent to Smarts Heath Common which is used for recreational purposes by local residents. Any expansion would impact the character and visual appearance of this green belt land.

GB8, GB9, GB10, GB11

I strongly object to proposals for housing on all the above sites. Mayford as a village will become a suburb of Woking therefore losing its character.

With the increase in housing the extra traffic to the whole area will become gridlocked. In addition low lying areas will be flooded due to run off and poor drainage. We must also take into consideration all the wild life habitat that will be destroyed leaving a huge void. This will make it difficult for wild life to survive.

I also share the same views as Mayford Village Society.
