

## **Objection to Release of green belt land in Upshot Lane Pyrford**

Dear Ms Jackson,

I am writing to you as I am very concerned about the proposal to release green belt land to build over 400 new houses in Pyrford.

We moved to Pyrford 6 years ago, because of the beautiful surroundings and peaceful village atmosphere, this will be completely destroyed by the addition of 2 housing estates.

The local area does not have the infrastructure to support so many new households. Pyrford C of E Primary School has been massively over subscribed in recent years, and that is even without the additional applications that would be generated by families moving into the new houses. The nearest doctor surgery is in West Byfleet, and I doubt very much that they have the capacity to take on potentially 1000 new patients.

Building over 400 new houses will mean an increase of potentially 800+ cars trying to use our local roads, this will lead to absolute gridlock. Coldharbour Road will be a main route for the increased number of cars, and there is already a significant problem on this road, especially during term time. Cars will frequently mount the curb to pass each other, putting pedestrians in extreme danger. There have already been accidents involving children being hit by cars, and the risk to pedestrians is will increase dramatically if the new houses are allowed to be built.
