Dear Head of Planning at WBC,

I am objecting to the current proposals to build on Green Belt land in and around Pyrford.

The local primary school has been expanded twice in recent years, with no corresponding improvements to local infrastructure; namely road capacity/ widening and parking.

This causes delays, frustration, and dangerous incidents at times, when certain road users do not respect the increased risks caused. Children and parents have been hurt as a result.

I believe that greater emphasis should be applied to building on brownfield sites in the Borough, or extending on existing sites.

If we encroach on green belt, we will begin to lose areas of separation between urban areas, thus creating greater urban masses.
