We wish to register our objection to planning application GB8 Nursery land adjacent to Egley Road Mayford GU22 OPL on the following grounds.

We can possibly understand the need for a new school and erosion of the greenbelt under special circumstances .

However there cannot possibly be the same reasoning behind a leisure centre and running track!

1. The erosion of the green belt - we are nearing the situation where there will be continuous structures between Woking and Mayford. Resulting in Mayford ultimately losing its own identity that has been in place for hundreds of years.
2. Poor infrastructure that cannot sustain the volume of traffic generated - the Egley Road is already heavily congested during the morning and evening rush hours. The proposed new School alone will obviously create several hundred traffic movements that coincides with the rush hour so the situation will become completely untenable as well as creating a substantial increase in exhaust fumes .
3. Flooding - we already have existing flooding at the entrance to the Woking garden centre. With land being concreted over this situation will deteriorate
4. Noise - the running track will obviously create a high noise level during any competition .
5. Light pollution - the haze of flood lights can be seen for many miles.
6. The lack of a full environmental impact assessment.
