I wish to send my objections/comments regarding the proposed building of over 400 new houses in Pyrford on Green Belt land. My objections are:

- the infrastructure generally will not stand more people coming into the area. It would mean more facilities would be required e.g. schooling, doctors, dentists, elderly care, shops etc.
- The roads are already congested at busy times (school & commuter traffic). The roads are too narrow and totally unsuitable for more traffic.
- Other local suggestions for building these houses in Parvis Road, W. Byfleet & Wisley airfield would have the same problems affecting Pyrford.
- Extra buildings on this scale would of course increase on the ecology as it would impact on water, sewage, gas & electricity usage.
- I feel the reason people come to live in this area is the character and pleasant environment and this will be badly undermined if this building goes ahead.

Please take these comments into considerations at the next stage of your planning.
