Dear Sirs,

I object in the strongest possible terms to the proposal for the building of housing on the above sites.

My concerns as a resident and tax payer are firstly that the intended removal of Green Belt land negates in every way the fundamental aim of the NPPF to prevent urban sprawl. The joining of Mayford to the rest of Woking would create the very thing the Green Belt exists to prevent.

My second objection is to the impact the addition of new housing would have on the infrastructure of the road system especially the A 320. Increased traffic would cause gridlock at busy times, the road is already static at key times of the day additional traffic from the proposed increased housing would make it worse.

I urge you to reconsider all your plans to keep the Mayford area as it was intended as separate from the town of Woking.
