I have only recently become aware of the detailed implications of the proposed Upshot Lane development. As somebody who makes frequent use of the footpaths in the fields between Pyrford and the River Wey, I would like to express my horror at what is proposed. It is really important to have countryside within walking distance of home – that is one of the reasons why we moved to Pyrford rather than other parts of Woking, when we left Essex five years ago.

I would therefore like to place on record my strong and heartfelt objection to the plans. I do not though object to the principle of expanding the stock of housing in Woking, and would like to see it done in areas where the impact could be minimized. Why for instance is the land between Morrisons and the town centre, where surely a large number of homes could be built without negative impact, not being developed.
