To the planning policy team,

I am very disappointed in the published result of the Green Belt Release.

1. The huge amount of extra traffic that will need to use Parvis Rd will make it grid locked at peak times such as school start and finish, and especially in the evening when people are returning from work.
2. The release in Byfleet does not take account of the flooding problem that is annual. More houses will mean more covered land and worse flooding.
3. The Government states that part of the purpose of the green belt was to stop neighbouring towns merging into one another. The large amount of housing proposed between Byfleet and West Byfleet seems designed to amalgamate the two. They are individual places and should not be joined together. Byfleet has a proud history as a village, it is not just part of a sprawling town.
