Thank you for providing an opportunity to express our views for the Pyrford Houses development project.

Our views are that by increasing the number of houses, and therefore the traffic, will increase the chance of accidents along the Coldharbour Road. It is always quite difficult to safely pass along the pavements currently, especially at school and church time, as the cars need to mount the pavements and with small children and pushchairs there have already been accidents and many incidents. The increase of traffic concerns our family a great deal.

The other concern is that it will change Pyrford from a close knit village into a mini town. A suggestion:

Why not further increase the 'Wisley airfield' development with proper infrastructure and keep Pyrford as an efficiently operating nearby village. That way you retain the historic feel of a neighbouring village (for all to enjoy) and create a sustainable new houses development with appropriate facilities. This would enable people to choose to live in a small village or a larger modern (maybe more affordable) housing estate. Each environment would be different but at least people have a choice.
