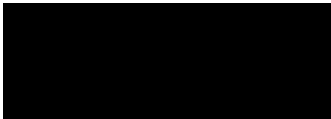

Objection – Development of sites GB12 & GB13 (Pyrford)

I am writing to register my objection to the proposed development plan for the two sites on either side of Upshot Lane, Pyrford.

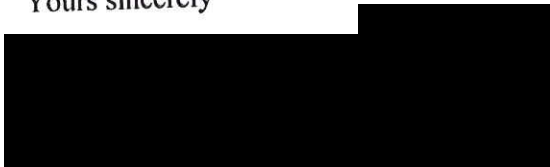
400 + new dwellings will mean that there will be a commensurate increase in traffic in an area that already suffers acute congestion at certain times of the day.

The local infrastructure of schooling, medical, welfare, leisure etc. will not be adequate to withstand the impact of any major increase in the local population – it is already stretched.

The Green Belt is precious to us all as it serves to stem the spread of urbanisation. Such a loss of green-space, should these developments be approved, would be inexcusable.

Past Government profligacy has led us into the present situation of over-population and the resultant needs for housing. Nevertheless, the Borough Council have a responsibility to the tax-paying public to preserve their social amenities by all means at their disposal – the Green Belt included.
