OBJECTION – Development of sites GB12 & 13

I wish to register my objection to the development plan for the two sites on either side of Upshot Lane for the following reasons:

1. 400+ new dwellings will create a need to accommodate approximately 600 more vehicles – an unacceptable rise in the volume of traffic in an area already blighted by severe congestion
2. 1,200+ more residents will overtax the existing infrastructure – schooling, medical, welfare, leisure, sewage disposal, water, etc
3. Such a loss of the Green Belt amenity that affords the Pyrford residents a rural aspect is intolerable
4. The proposed development will degrade the ancient village of Pyrford and increase the strain of traffic along Church Hill and Warren Lane – roads that are narrow or (in the case of Warren Lane) very narrow

Madam, this proposed development of Green belt land within the Pyrford neighbourhood is objectionable to the vast majority of existing Pyrford residents and should not be supported by the very council that exists for the people of the borough of Woking and is beholden unto them.
