Dear Jeni Jackson,

My husband and I feel compelled to write to submit our objections to the release of green belt land around Pyrford. As Woking residents this is an issue that will affect us directly. Our main concerns are as follows:

1. The impact on local access roads. These are already very busy, and sometimes reduce down to narrow, single lanes. 423 new houses in the immediate vicinity is of course going to bring in excess of 400 extra vehicles to roads which will cause extreme disruption to the area.
2. There will be a substantial impact to the local woodlands and wildlife. One of the features of this part of the County is the woodlands and 'countryside' feel to the area. Any loss of trees and woodlands will diminish the beauty of the local area. We often see wild deer and fox roaming in the local woods, and have seen a badger nest - these would be sorely missed.
3. There seems to have been inconsistencies in the assessment methodology process for the sites.

We strongly urge you to reconsider other options for new housing.
