I am writing to strongly object to the Green Belt Release proposals for Byfleet, by Woking Borough Council, for the following reasons.

1. Byfleet has only a small amount of Green Belt land surrounding our village, what we have, must be preserved.
2. Parvis Road (A245) is already gridlocked many days, more housing will only make this situation worse.
3. Our schools and health centre are already over subscribed, this situation must be rectified before any more housing is even considered for Byfleet.
4. The drainage system in Byfleet cannot take any more usage, it is not up to the task at present, any more usage and it will fail.
5. The roads in Byfleet are narrow and already inadequate for the traffic using them.
6. Much of Byfleet and the proposed area has been flooded or is in danger of flooding, this Green belt must be used to alleviate the flooding, building houses on it, will not do this.
7. The Byfleet Petition with some 2,500 names has been ignored.

Byfleet and the surrounding area are already full, we cannot accommodate any more people, building or traffic.
