Subject: Policy GB7 The Release of Nursery land adjacent to Egley Road Mayford, GU22 0PL

We are writing to reiterate our strong opposition to this development proposal. As residents in Westfield Road for 23 years, we have a deep affection for this area and are very upset by the continuing desecration of this lovely, once semi-rural, location. This latest proposal represents another nail in the coffin for both the character of Mayford and the fast dwindling green belt.

In particular, we are concerned about:

- The loss of the green lung between Mayford and Woking, creating one big metropolitan area and destroying Mayford's village status;
- The loss of many trees, and therefore wildlife, in favour of concrete...;
- Far more congested roads in an area that has already suffered a massive increase in traffic, precipitating gridlock and more accidents, as well as noise and pollution;
- Even more pressure on local services.

The council seems hell-bent on turning Mayford into a concrete corridor. This is not what many of the villagers want.

Please, enough! Preserve what's left of the village for future generations. Once it's gone, we'll never get it back and we will only have photos to remind us of what a lovely and special place Mayford once was.
